Introduction

This addendum provides additional information to the CTMP Rev 04 produced for Central Station Main Works.

Through design development, it has been identified that works need to be undertaken in the Mortuary Station sidings and along the Darling Harbour Goods Line. This addendum outlines the access arrangements for construction vehicles entering the rail corridor via the Lee St Bus Depot.

Access to the Lee St Bus Depot will be in line with the current access protocol for buses.

Compliance Matrix

Minister's Conditions of Approval

The Minister's Conditions of Approval (CoA) are addressed in Table 1 with the full descriptions provided in Appendix F of Central Station Main Works Project Construction Traffic Management Plan Rev 4.

Programme of Works

This access will be utilised by construction vehicles to construct the project wide Combined Service Route (CSR) and for material laydown and handling commencing September 2019 to December 2020, all of which require access to the Mortuary Sidings.

Our activities will not impact pedestrian movements. Pedestrian crossing in front of either access or exit points are controlled by lights. Within the bus yard the pedestrian footpaths that are currently marked on the ground will be maintained.

These works will be 24 hours a day, on weekends during a railway possession. Outside a railway possession these works will be 07:00 – 18:00 Monday to Friday and Saturday 08:00 – 13:00.



Route of travel







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




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
Approved Heavy Vehicle Route beyond the entrance / exit to Mortuary Sidings






